

RESCUE DEPARTMENT FOR TRAINING

The statutory tasks of the Central Mine Rescue Station S.A. in Bytom include organizing mine rescue training and taking care of the appropriate level of training of mine rescuers.

- I. Courses and seminars under the provisions of the Mine Rescue Ordinance:
- Basic course for candidates for mine rescuers.
- Periodic course for mine rescuers.
- Basic course for candidates for rescue equipment mechanics.
- Periodic course for mechanics of rescue equipment.
- Seminar for managers of mining plant operations managers of rescue operations.
- Course for underground action managers.
- Course for managers of rescue bases.
- Seminar for traffic dispatchers in underground mining plants.
- Basic course for candidates for managers of mine rescue stations.
- Periodic course for managers of mine rescue stations.
- A course for managers of rescue operations staff.
- Periodic course in mine rescue for managers and supervisors of underground mining plant operations who are not part of the rescue team.
- A course for deputy mine rescue teams in first aid.
- Course in qualified first aid for mine rescuers (basic course).
- A recertification course in qualified first aid for mine rescuers.

- II. Specialized training for mine rescue workers:
- Basic course for mine rescuers, candidates for members of specialized rescue teams for work using mountaineering techniques.
- Course for candidates for managers of specialized rescue teams for work using mountaineering techniques.
- Course for candidates for mechanics of specialized rescue equipment used in mountaineering techniques.
- Course for mine rescuers, candidates for deputies of specialized rescue teams for work with the use of mountaineering techniques.
- Conditioning and training grouping of specialized rescue squads for work with the use of mountaineering techniques.
- III. Training to improve the skills of mine services:
- Course in the use of escape respiratory protective equipment.
- Course on maintenance of fire protection equipment.
- Course in the use of fire prevention equipment.
- Course for supervisors on fire protection of underground mining plants.
- Course for persons performing measurements of physical and chemical parameters of the mine atmosphere.
- Course for persons inspecting instruments for measuring parameters of mine atmosphere.
- Course for persons applying for obtaining a qualification certificate for filling portable pressure vessels of capacity > 350cm3 in the field: compressed gases - cylinders.
- A course for persons employed in the maintenance and inspection of regenerative escape apparatuses with chemically bound oxygen and purification equipment.
- Course for persons employed in the operation of mining lamps.
- Course for the operation of a gas chromatograph.
- Course for mine laboratory technicians in gas analysis.
- Course for managers of mine laboratories.
- Course for mine paramedics.
